

Energy Storage Resources in RPM

Includes Problem/Opportunity Statement

Issue Source

Demansys requests that PJM stakeholders consider tariff changes to allow interconnected energy storage resources to participate in RPM.

Stakeholder Group Assignment

MRC, to be delegated to the CSTF or other group as decided by the MRC.

Key Work Activities

Review of existing rules regarding limited energy resources.

Development of proposed Tariff and Operating Agreement revisions to address:

- 1. Requirements for interconnected energy storage resources to qualify as an RPM resource.
- Procedures for energy storage resources to participate in RPM auctions, and for measuring energy storage resource performance.
- 3. Requirements for offering planned energy storage resources in RPM auctions.
- Consistency across energy storage and limited energy resources.

Expected Deliverables

Proposed Tariff and Operating Agreement revisions.

Expected Overall Duration of Work

Recommendations should be returned to the MRC after 6 to 10 meetings of the assigned subcommittee. Work to begin as soon as subcommittee workloads allow.

Decision-Making Method

Preferred is Tier I, consensus on a single proposal. Failing that, Tier II, multiple proposals...
