Administration

Mr. Falin opened the meeting and reviewed the agenda. Mr. Quevada performed roll call. The meeting minutes from the September 6, 2018 meeting were approved and will be posted as final.

2018 RRS Results and Discussion

Mr. Rocha-Garrido presented the 2018 Reserve Requirement Study (RRS) report and summarized the results. The subcommittee endorsed the Installed Reserve Margin and Forecast Pool Requirement for the 2019/2020, 2020/2021, 2021/2022 and 2022/2023 delivery years with no objections and no abstentions. The recommendation will be communicated to the Planning Committee.

The results of the 2018 RRS are summarized below:
