Third Settlement, referred to as Settlement C

- Provides EDCs with ability to true-up significant metering or billing errors beyond the 60-day or Settlement B timeframe
- Current Settlement C process as defined in the tariff requires agreement by all affected parties
- Members have experienced issues in gaining consensus to resolve a billing error
- Existing process doesn't define specifics on communication and timing



- Considerations for Settlement C process
 - Define an official process similar to Settlement B
 - Identify improvements for handling resettlement between multiple parties
 - Communication
 - Timeline
 - Dispute Resolution
 - Extend the current two year window for resettlements
