PJM has identified that there has been significant movement in economic indicators, particularly interest rates that can impact the financial parameters used in the calculation of the Cost of New Entry ("CONE"). Accurate Gross CONE calculations are needed to ensure valid price signals that support system reliability.

Key Work Activities and Scope

- 1. Review results from The Brattle Group for updated financial parameters
- Review Quadrennial Review financial parameters used to calculate Gross CONE starting with the 26/27 BRA
- 3. Present updated financial parameters calculated by a consultant and impact on Gross CONE
- 4. Determine if an additional financial adjustment is necessary to account for changing financial parameters

Out of Scope

- 1. Changes to E&AS calculation
- 2. Changes to the VRR Curve

Expected Deliverables

PJM will propose updated financial parameters for calculating Gross CONE for the 27/28 BRA and subsequent delivery years. Following approval, PJM will submit a FERC filing to update the financial parameters used to calculate Gross CONE and introduce a new annual financial adjustment to account for changing financial parameters. Additionally, the updated Reference Resource CONE will be updated for the MOPR Gross CONE for alignment.
