Problem Statement/Issue Source

The FTR forfeiture rule has been applied in the same way since its inception in January 2001. The FTR forfeiture rule has not been subject to a thorough stakeholder review since that time.

Conducting a stakeholder review at this time would ensure that interested stakeholders have access to educational sessions on the operation of the rule. If necessary, this process would allow interested stakeholders to propose and consider modifications to the rule.

Stakeholder Group Assignment

The MMU recommends that the MRC resolve the issue without assignment.

Key Work Activities

1. Review the FTR forfeiture rule.
2. Review non-confidential data on the application of the FTR forfeiture rule.
3. Review options for implementation of the FTR forfeiture rule.
4. Determine if changes to the FTR forfeiture rule should be proposed.
 - a. Examine whether bid volumes should be incorporated in the FTR forfeiture rule.
5. If necessary, develop Tariff and Manual changes.

Expected Deliverables

If necessary, revised Tariff and Manual language.

Expected Overall Duration of Work

The MMU expects that this work effort can be completed within six months.
