Key Work Activities

The group is expected to:

- 1. Identify governmental actions that states may take that could adversely negatively impact the objective of RPMthe capacity and energy-markets to send efficient market signals for resource investment and exit.
- Identify the objectives of a-well-functioning capacity and energy market constructs that addresses statesgovernments' public policy needs and objectives
- 3. Given the results from Activities 2 and 3, brainstorm and develop modifications to RPM <u>and the energy</u> <u>market</u> to address identified threats and how these modifications could meet the identified objectives. If deemed appropriate, select the preferred approach and develop detailed business rules.

Expected Deliverables

Deliverables are expected to include changes to PJM Operating Agreement, Tariff, Reliability Assurance Agreement and manuals.

Expected Overall Duration of Work

The duration of activities in the group are expected to be completed by the end of the third quarter of 2017.

Decision-Making Method

Group will seek Tier 1, consensus (unanimity) on a single proposal for the issues identified in the group.
