

## Motion to Delay Comparative Framework Development

All Provisions, Policy Direction and Words in May 24, 2018 MRC motion remain exactly as approved, except that all implementation dates in the MRC motion “Section C) Alternative Motion Regarding Comparative Framework” are extended by one calendar year.

This specifically means:

- The initial Comparative Framework, after seeking the advice and recommendation of the PJM IMM, shall be developed by September 1, 2019.
- The initial Comparative Framework shall be presented to the MRC no later than December 1, 2019, along with the advice and recommendation of the PJM IMM, for a vote and to be effective for PJM windows commencing after January 1, 2020.
- An additional ROE Comparative Framework shall be presented to MRC no later than May 1, 2020, along with advice and recommendation of PJM IMM, for vote and to be effective for PJM windows commencing after May 1, 2020.
- The specific Analytical Framework and policies outlined in Section B of the May 24, 2018 MRC motion shall be used by the Office of Interconnection in developing any of the forthcoming Analytical Frameworks, including both the initial Comparative Framework and additional ROE framework.
- The OA language approved at June 2018 MC shall be filed at FERC no later than September 2019 and with a requested effective date of no later than January 1, 2020.

Notwithstanding any of the above, the original provision in the May 24, 2018 MRC Motion that states:

- “The materials provided to the TEAC shall describe in a clear and transparent manner, the method by which the Office of Interconnection scrutinized the cost aspects of each finalist proposal, including any binding cost commitments”

shall be effective (and included in Manual 14F, Section 8.1.5 Project Recommendation Section) starting for the PJM November 1, 2018 windows.
