FERC opens paper hearing on 10-hour rule for energy storage resources



Apr. – Sep. 2020

- Capacity Capability Senior Task Force (CCSTF) works on developing provisions to establish ELCC methodology



Jan. – Mar. 2020

- PJM discusses Effective Load Carrying Capability (ELCC) with stakeholders
- ELCC issue charge endorsed by MRC and Capacity Capability Senior Task Force (CCSTF) is formed



Oct. 2020

- FERC Filing (see Slide 4 for additional details)

- 3 packages voted at the MRC
- Joint Stakeholder with Amendment package endorsed

- PJM filed Joint Stakeholder with Amendment package at FERC

- FERC rejects PJM's ELCC proposal

- PJM submitted revised filing to FERC

- FERC Order accepting PJM revised proposal
- Effective August 1, 2021 for DY 23/24

Phase II work moved to Resource Adequacy Senior Task Force (RASTF)

- Discuss other rules or rule changes that may be necessary for limited duration resources to participate in energy and ancillary service markets
 - Develop rules in CCSTF or other group determined by stakeholders
- Agreement to Further Evaluate the Operations of Limited Duration Resources
 - Part of the Amendment to the Joint Stakeholder package

- Phase I work completed
- Phase II work moved to the RASTF

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
