- FERC approved Load Management (LM) and Price Responsive Demand (PRD) testing changes in 2020
- Changes become effective starting June 2023
- Changes designed to better simulate LM/PRD event conditions
- Removed references to now obsolete LM products
- Note formatting changes to M18 since presented at MIC to accommodate publishing software requirements
 - No language changes
 - Only subsection numbering and referencing changes from character (i.e. A, B, C) to numeric (i.e. 1, 2, 3)

- M18, Sections 3A.6.3 for PRD and 8.7 for LM
 - PJM schedules tests
 - One test per year (test required only if not dispatched)
 - Retesting provisions
 - Tests are two hours in duration
 - Test can take place year-round consistent with CP
 - Three tiered notification process
- M28, Sections 11.1 and 11.2.1.A
 - CSPs are compensated for LM test MWh reductions
- M01, Section 1.9
 - Electronic notification utilized

- The MIC endorsed the changes to M18 and M28 at its June meeting. 0 objections and 0 abstentions
- The OC endorsed the changes to M01 at its June meeting. 0 objections and 0 abstentions
