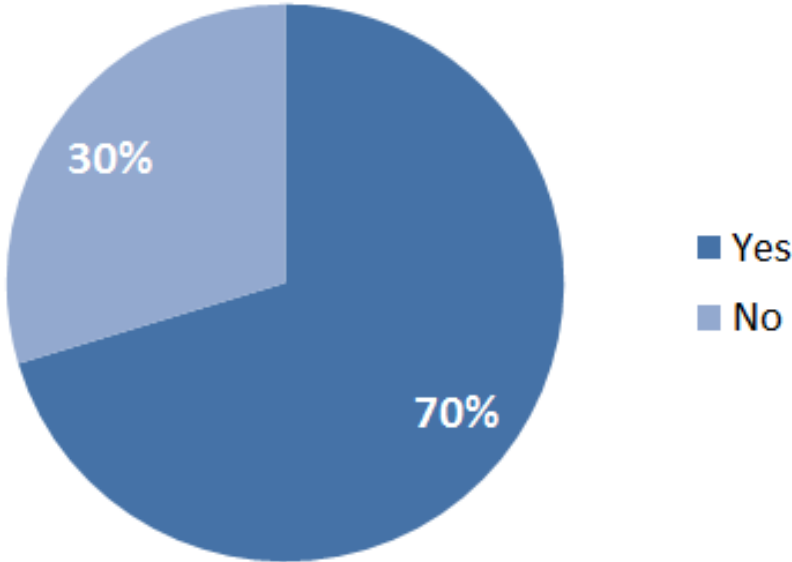
- **Existing Power Meter submission deadlines:**

 - Friday Sunday Operating Days: Monday @ 3pm EPT
- **Existing InSchedule submission deadlines:**
 - Monday – Thursday Operating Days: Next business day @ 2pm EPT
 - Friday - Sunday Operating Days: Monday @ 5pm EPT
- **Revised Power Meter submission deadlines:**
 - Monday – Thursday Operating Days: Next business day @ 4pm EPT
 - Friday - Sunday Operating Days: Monday @ 4pm EPT
- **Revised InSchedule submission deadlines:**
 - Monday - Thursday Operating Days: Two business days @ 4pm EPT
 - Friday - Sunday Operating Days: Tuesday @ 4pm EPT

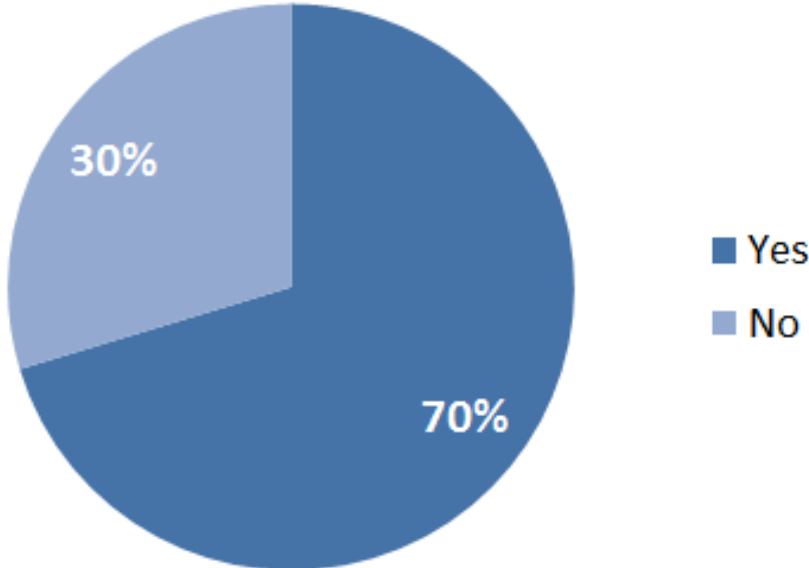

Can you support a 10/1/2014 implementation date?





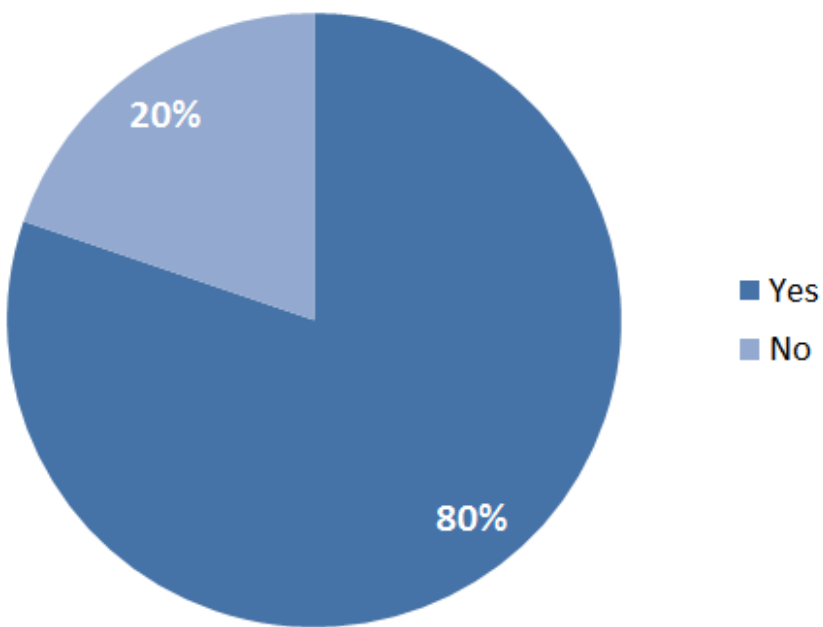
Question # 3: Do you support the proposed Reconciliation of Balancing Operating Reserve for Deviations?

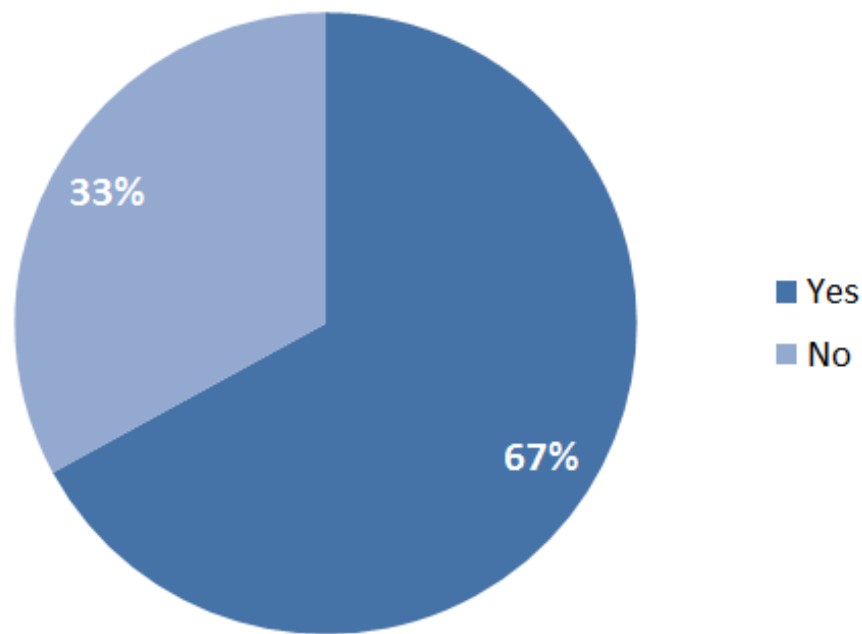


Inclusion of BOR Deviation in Reconciliation

Extension of Monthly Meter Correction Submission

Question # 5: Do you support the proposed extension of Monthly Meter Correction submissions?

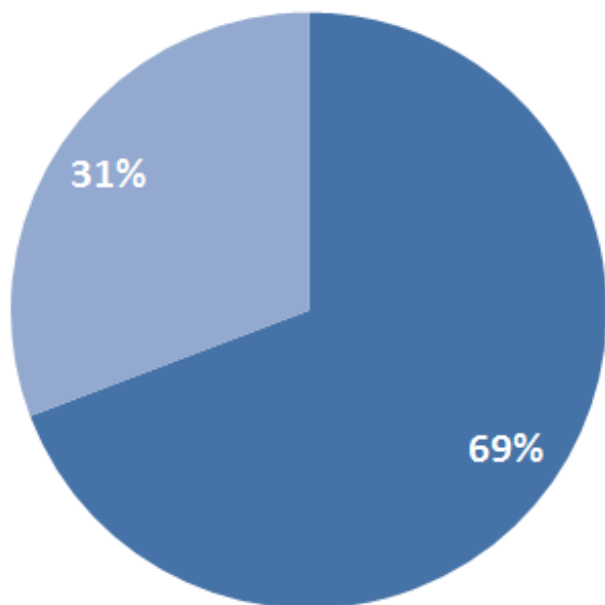
- **Existing Monthly Meter Correction submission deadlines:**
 - Data due 3rd business day after the last day of the month
 - Included in monthly bill for operating month
- **Proposed Monthly Meter Correction submission deadlines:**
 - Data due by last day of next month
 - Billed in month following operating month

Question # 6: Can you support a proposed implementation date of October 1, 2014?



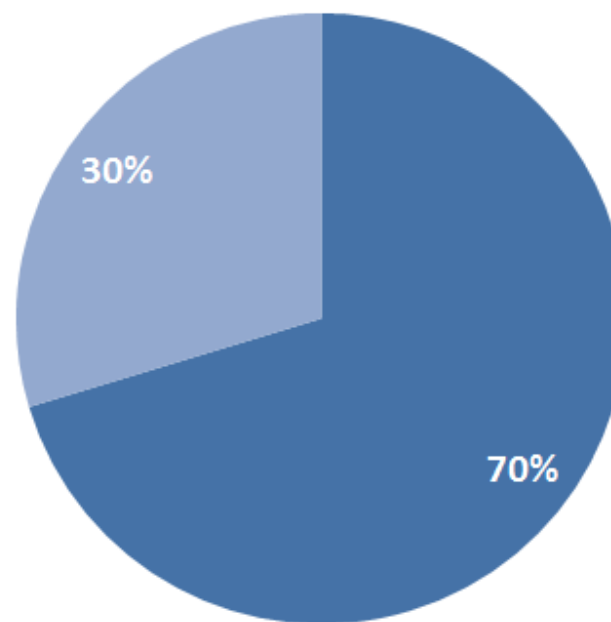
Extension of Monthly Meter Correction Submission
