- Complete
  - KWA 1 Clean Attribute Procurement Sr. Task Force Issue Charge approved and working
  - KWA 9 (MSOC) Market Power Mitigation Narrow proposal failed at MRC, broader matrix proposals first read at August MRC
- In Progress Interest Identification, Education, Design Components & some options developed
  - KWA 2 Reliability Risks and Risk Drivers
  - KWA 3 Procurement Metric and Level
  - KWA 4 Performance Expectation
  - KWA 5 Qualification and Accreditation
  - KWA 6 Obligations
- Seasonal Capacity Construct Opportunities (intertwined with KWAs 2-6 and 8)
  - Some stakeholder perspectives have been shared for discussion



- Dichotomy between discrete KWAs and holistic framework
  - Continuing to work in siloed KWA matrices presents challenges
  - Opportunity to work in a broader context to ensure holistic framework
- Critical Pivot Opportunity
  - Pause work on specific KWAs
  - Present PJM and stakeholder high level / holistic resource adequacy concepts
    - Once several holistic concepts are identified, use these to drive development of corresponding KWA matrices
    - Then advance the individual KWA matrices in parallel
