### **NOTICE TO INTERESTED PARTIES OF CORRECTION TO THE 2019 NETWORK SERVICE RATE FOR AMPT FACILITIES IN THE ATSI TRANSMISSION ZONE OF PJM**

#### To All Interested Parties:

On November 1, 2018, AMP Transmission LLC (“AMPT”) and PJM Interconnection, LLC (“PJM”) jointly filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“FERC”) in FERC Docket No. ER19-263-000 a proposed formula transmission rate template and formula rate implementation protocols for AMPT-owned or leased transmission facilities under PJM’s functional control. AMPT’s filing also included for notice purposes its projected transmission revenue requirement (“Annual Projection”) and Network Service rate for calendar year 2019 for AMPT-owned facilities in the American Transmission Systems, Incorporated (“ATSI”) Transmission Zone of PJM to be effective for service provided during calendar year 2019. The November 1, 2018 filing was posted by PJM and is available online at <https://www.pjm.com/directory/etariff/FercDockets/3839/20181101-ER19-263-000.pdf>. Using the calculated Annual Projection set forth at in the posted filing (PDF pages 281-298 of 303) and the ATSI Zone Network Service Peak Load (NSPL) available to AMPT at the time of its filing, AMPT calculated a Network Service rate for its ATSI Zone facilities of \$138.50 per MW. AMPT stated that this rate would be applied to collect the projected revenue requirement for its ATSI Zone facilities, subject to true-up as set forth in AMPT’s proposed formula rate protocols, beginning January 1, 2019.

Subsequent to its filing, AMPT was advised that the ATSI Zone NSPL value used to calculate the foregoing Network Service rate is incorrect. Use of the correct ATSI Zone NSPL value (12,825.8 MW) does not affect the AMPT projected revenue requirement but does affect the calculated Network Service rate. **Interested parties are hereby advised that the corrected Network Service rate for AMPT-owned facilities in the ATSI Zone during 2019 is \$130.20 per MW.** AMPT will request that PJM Settlement utilize the corrected rate to collect AMPT’s ATSI Zone revenue requirement during 2019, subject to true up.
