Dear Secretary Reese:

Pursuant to Section 205 of the Federal Power Act,¹ PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (“PJM”) submits for filing to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) revisions to the Consolidated Transmission Owners Agreement (“CTOA”).² FirstEnergy, on behalf of its PJM transmission-owning affiliates, requested that PJM amend the CTOA signature blocks for Keystone Appalachian Transmission Company (“KATCo”) and Monongahela Power Company (“Mon Power”) and The Potomac Edison Company (“Potomac Edison”), doing business as Allegheny Power (collectively, the “FirstEnergy Transmission Owners”) to reflect the January 1, 2024 signature dates for their respective CTOA signature blocks which are included in the tariff records already accepted by the Commission in this proceeding.³

PJM respectfully requests that the Commission accept the enclosed revisions with an effective date of May 26, 2024.

I. BACKGROUND

On November 1, 2023, FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company (“FE PA”), and KATCo filed modifications to the PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff (“Tariff”), Amended and Restated Operating Agreement of PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (“Operating Agreement”), Reliability Assurance Agreement Among Load Serving Entities in the PJM Region (“RAA”), and the CTOA (together, the “PJM Governing Agreements”) in connection with the integration of FE PA and KATCo into PJM as a result of FirstEnergy’s proposed internal corporate reorganization (the “Transaction”) (“November 1 Filing”).⁴

At the time of the November 1 Filing, FE PA and KATCo anticipated that the Transaction would close on January 1, 2024, but the exact date was not certain. Thus, PJM requested an open-ended effective date of 12/31/9998 for the PJM Governing Agreements revisions attached to the November 1 Filing. In the November 1 Filing, PJM submitted for filing, as part of the PJM CTOA revisions, a signature page to the PJM CTOA executed by KATCo. In addition, PJM filed to revise the PJM CTOA removing West Penn from the Allegheny Power signature block because West Penn Power was replaced by FE PA. Because the effective date of the Transaction was not yet known at the time of the November 1 Filing, the dates for the signature blocks for the FirstEnergy Transmission Owners were left blank.

In the Letter Order, the Commission accepted the November 1 Filing effective 12/31/9998, as requested, subject to PJM submitting a compliance filing to notify the Commission of the actual

effective date of the tariff records within 30 days of the effective date of the tariff records (*i.e.*, within 30 days of the FE PA and KATCo Transaction closing date).

On January 29, 2024, PJM filed a supplemental filing (“Supplemental Filing”) to comply with the Commission’s Letter Order. The Supplemental Filing provided the Commission with the effective date of January 1, 2024, the date of the consummation of the Transaction and effective date of the revisions already accepted by the Commission.

II. DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED REVISIONS

On January 5, 2024, FirstEnergy submitted a filing to notify the Commission that the Transaction was consummated on January 1, 2024.⁵ Therefore, PJM hereby submits for filing revised signature blocks dates adding January 1, 2024 as the execution dates for the FirstEnergy Transmission Owners.

IV. PROPOSED EFFECTIVE DATE

PJM respectfully requests that the Commission accept the enclosed revisions to the PJM Tariff and CTOA, effective May 26, 2024.
